

**CRITERIA FOR MARTIN COUNTY
4-H FOUNDATION
SCHOLARSHIP**

The Martin County 4-H Scholarship Committee met on November 9, 1992. The following criteria was decided upon and accepted unanimously on February 8, 1993 by the Martin County 4-H Foundation.

- A) The 4-H member must be well rounded in 4-H, involved in many aspects of 4-H, and be a member of 4-H for two consecutive years.**
- B) They must be in good standing with 4-H.**
- C) The money can go for Room/Board/Books/Tuition/Transportation.**
- D) The 4-H member can receive the scholarship only once.**
- E) The 4-H member can apply in their senior year of high school OR their freshman year in college.**
- F) The committee that chooses the youth will have members from the 4-H Foundation and 4-H Leaders.**
- G) The 4-H member's total 4-H record will be taken into consideration. This includes: camps, conferences, state programs, workshops, community involvement, club involvement District Events, County Events and State Events.**
- H) This scholarship is to be used for higher education ONLY, this includes technical schools.**
- I) The youth will have completed high school and obtained a diploma or obtained a GED to apply.**

The youth will NOT be penalized for:

- a) School averages- it was a consensus of the 4-H Foundation that if a child can get into college or technical school and is willing to work, they deserve any help that can be supplied.**
- b) Since money can be made on animal projects, the child will not be penalized for participating in these 4-H projects.**

Money will be dispersed to the child upon entrance into a school of higher education.
