WHEN: Saturday, September 13, 2008, 9AM

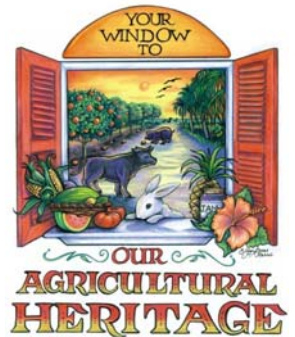
WHERE: Building A of the Martin County Fair Grounds.
